Corn Background

• Taxonomical Family – Poaceae

- Grasses
- Angiosperms
 - Monoecious "same house"

Corn Background

- Hypogeal Emergence
 - Makes plant more protected towards aboveground pests



- Came from Europe in the early 1900s
- Part of the Lepidoptera Order

Effects of Borer on Corn

- Larvae eat through stem in buckshot feeding
- Causes Lodging
- Multiple
 Generations per season

Preventative Means

- Insecticides
 - Ineffective once larvae bore into stalk
 - Resistance Natural Selection
- Biotech Corn
 - Bacillus thuringiensis
 - Protein—Bt delta endotoxin—harmful only to Lepidoptera larvae
